- ☆ CentAccount™ Incentive Program promotes personal healthcare responsibility and ownership by offering financial incentives. The reward is loaded onto a health plan issued CentAccount debit card. You can use this card at many merchants you already use every day, such as nationally recognized drugstores and supermarkets to buy a wide variety of health care items. This incentive reward is offered for the completion of annual well child visits.
- Fluvention: Your child can participate in this annual flu prevention campaign which gives outreach to high-risk Members. You and your child can receive information about flu prevention and how to stay healthy.

#### Case Management

If your child has special healthcare needs or is disabled, case management may be able to help you. Sunshine Health case managers are registered nurses or social workers. They can help you understand your child's health problems and arrange care with his/her doctors. A case manager will work with you and the doctor to help your child get the care they need.
