New Text Message Payment Option Available

Florida KidCare is happy to provide another convenient way for you to make payments — text message.



Signing up for text pay is simple. Just log on to https://mypayments.bill2pay.com/login/kidcare to get started. A video with step-by-step instructions is also available at www.youtube.com/floridahealthykids to help you through the process.

Once you sign up, you will receive a text message from Florida KidCare asking if you want to pay by text. Respond with "yes" and the debit/credit card or checking account on file will be debited the amount of your monthly premium.

Renewal Process Easy as 1, 2, 3

Once a year every family enrolled in the Florida KidCare program must renew their child's

coverage. Thanks to new updates, the process will be easier than ever before for many families.

Previously, you had to review your renewal application to make sure the basic information was correct; then you had to provide proof of income, any unemployment compensation and citizenship. Now, because of a partnership with the Florida Department of Revenue and the



Agency for Workforce Innovation, this information will be filled in for you if we receive your current information electronically from these state agencies. Then, all you will need to do is 1-review it for accuracy, 2-sign it and 3-send it in! Easy as 1, 2, 3!

Please note, that if DOR or AWI is unable to provide current income, any unemployment compensation and citizenship information; or if you have changes, you will still need to submit the appropriate documentation for renewal.

As a reminder, you can submit your renewal application one of four ways:

- ⇒ **Online:** Log into your account to complete the online renewal form.
